Methodology Notes: The survey was conducted through telephone and fax communication with each of the 34 municipalities and states. Most commonly, the offices of the clerk and/or the public legal department were the purveyors of information, indicating the Enacted of the ordinance or resolution and noting whether or not the specific regulation is still being enforced. After the initial round of correspondence, all those localities that were shown to still have and enforce selective purchasing acts were sent a letter seeking to confirm this conclusion and give the relevant government officials a chance to respond.
